4. Along with this Honors Institute/Honors Fellowship application, please submit a double-spaced, three-to-five page essay giving a verbal portrait of yourself. Among the matters to include in this essay are the following:
 - your most important personality and character traits
 - why and how studying and reading are important in your life
 - what you are looking for from your college experience
5. Two letters of recommendation are to be submitted (separately or together with your Honors Institute/Honors Fellowship Application) to the Belmont Abbey College Office of Admissions. At least one of these letters should be from one of your teachers. Both should shed light on your intellectual ability and character.
6. In order to be granted an Honors Fellowship, all applicants need to take part in a **Scholarship Interview**. Finalists among students who submit this (standard form) application will be announced in January and will be invited to a Scholarship Weekend in February. Ordinarily, Scholarship interviews will take place during the course of this weekend. Finalists who are unable to attend the February Scholarship Weekend will need to contact the Honors Institute Director prior to January 31st in order to schedule a Scholarship Interview at a mutually convenient time.
7. Recipients of an Honors Fellowship will receive up to \$20,000 in financial assistance. The latter will be inclusive of other forms of institutional aid from Belmont Abbey College as well as of any federal or state grants for which a student may be eligible.

As a condition for reception of the Honors Fellowship, a student must reside on campus.
