Databases & Indexes

NOTE: When full-text is not available from one of the Library's databases, please use our Interlibrary Loan (ILL) service to obtain materials from other institutions. ILL forms are available from the Library Reference Desk. Please allow up to two weeks for delivery of ILL items.

Subject Specific

[SPORTDiscus](#) (available from the Library's Databases page)

Comprehensive, bibliographic database covering sport, physical fitness, exercise, sports medicine, physical education, kinesiology, training, disabled persons, drugs, health, health education, biomechanics, movement science, injury prevention rehabilitation, physical therapy, rehabilitation, nutrition, exercise physiology, sport & exercise psychology, occupational health & therapy, public health and more. Content includes bibliographic coverage for journal and magazine articles, books, book chapters, conference proceedings, dissertations, theses, and reference to articles in 60 different languages. Selected full-text.

[ABI/Inform Complete](#) (available from the Library's Databases page)

Database of business and economics periodicals including scholarly journals, magazines, newspapers, trade publications, newsletters and company information covering all aspects of trade and industry such as marketing, management, finance, advertising, human resources, taxation, technology, and more. Selected full-text.

[America's Newspapers](#) (available from the Library's Databases page)

Provides unique coverage of local and regional news, including companies, politics, sports, industries, cultural activities, and people in the community, as well as a distinctive focus offering a variety of viewpoints on local and world issues. Paid ads are excluded.

[Business Source Premier](#) (via NC LIVE; available from the Library's Databases page)

Provides full text for more than 2,300 journals, including full text for more than 1,100 peer-reviewed titles. *Business Source Premier* is superior to the competition in full text coverage in all disciplines of business, including marketing, management, MIS, POM, accounting, finance and economics.

[ERIC \(Education Resources Information Center\)](#)

(via NC LIVE; available from the Library's Databases page)

Database of journal articles and other education-related materials including books, research syntheses, conference reports, technical reports, and policy papers from scholarly organizations, professional associations, research centers, policy organizations, university

presses, the U.S. Department of Education and other federal agencies, and state and local agencies. Also available on the Web at <http://www.eric.ed.gov/>

Lexis-Nexis Academic Universe (available from the Library's Databases page)

Full-text database covering news, business, and legal sources. The legal portion of Lexis-Nexis includes access to federal, state, and international legislation as well as U.S. federal regulations, court proceedings and decisions. Legal journals, law reviews and other legal periodicals are also included. The News portion provides full-text access to major U.S. newspapers and news magazines, with selected local newspapers also included.

ProQuest (Education, Religion) (available from the Library's Databases page)

Access to over 760 educational publications, including more than 600 of the titles in full text. Selected articles also include all the charts, tables, diagrams, and other graphical elements. Coverage includes not only the literature on primary, secondary, and higher education but also special education, home schooling, adult education, and hundreds of related topics.

Regional Business News (via NC LIVE; available from the Library's Databases page)

This database provides comprehensive full text coverage for regional business publications. Regional Business News incorporates coverage of 75 business journals, newspapers and newswires from all metropolitan and rural areas within the United States. **Note:** See **America's Newspapers** for coverage of NC news sources including full-text of the *Charlotte Observer* (1985 – pres.) and *Raleigh News & Observer* (1991 – pres.).

Sport and Recreation Index/Sport and Fitness Index (1977 – 1985) (Ref Row 29)

From the Sport Information Resource Centre, a Division of the Coaching Association of Canada, this multilingual resource indexes the major sport and recreation journals for the time period covered.

Related Areas

InfoTrac OneFile (available from the Library's Databases page)

A one-stop source for news and periodical articles on a wide range of topics: business, computers, current events, economics, education, environmental issues, health care, hobbies, humanities, law, literature and art, politics, science, social science, sports, technology, and many general interest topics. Selected full-text and images.

JSTOR (available from the Library's Databases page)

Interdisciplinary, searchable, full-text archive of almost 1,000 academic journals covering the humanities, social sciences, and life sciences. Journals are always included from volume 1, issue 1 and include previous and related titles. The most recently published issues (past 3-5 years) are not available. However, users can search this material and link to the publisher's site or other online source for access. New content is added on a regular basis as it is made available by the publisher. Advanced search options include author name, title, abstract, and caption for photographs and other images.

SpringerLink (available from the Library's Databases page)

Database of *selected* full-text journals in a variety of subject areas including humanities, social sciences and law, and behavioral science. (NOTE: Full-text access to reference materials and e-books is NOT available. Full-text access to the most recent 3 – 6 months of journals may also be restricted.)

Wiley InterScience (available from the Library's Databases page)

Online collection of books and journals covering scientific, technical, medical, and humanities and social sciences content.

Note: In addition to providing access to individual databases, **NC LIVE** also provides a general search interface that allows you to search multiple databases at the same time. Performing this type of search is a good way to identify databases with the most information on a topic, as well as providing multi-disciplinary coverage for a topic.
