4. Along with this Honors Institute/Honors Fellowship application, submit a double-spaced, three- to- five page essay giving a verbal portrait of yourself. --- Among the matters to include in this essay are the following:
 - your most important personality and character traits
 - why and how studying and reading are important in your life
 - what you are looking for from your college experience
5. Two letters of recommendation are to be submitted (separately or together with your Honors Institute/Honors Fellowship Application) to the Belmont Abbey College Office of Admissions. At least one of these letters should be from one of your teachers. Both should shed light on your intellectual ability and character.
6. In order to be granted an Honors Fellowship, applicants need to take part in a Scholarship Interview. This interview ordinarily takes place during one of our two Scholarship Weekends. If you are not able to attend a Scholarship Weekend, you must contact the Honors Institute Director in order to schedule a Scholarship Interview. An interview scheduled in this way must take place no later than February 1, 2010. **Please note that there will be an Early Decision Scholarship Weekend on November 13-14, 2009. A second Scholarship Weekend will take place on February 12-13, 2010.**
7. Recipients of an Honors Fellowship will receive up to \$20,000 in financial assistance. The latter may include and will not be additional to other forms of institutional aid from Belmont Abbey College. Recipients of an Honors Fellowship must reside on campus.
8. Please note that students who apply for the Honors Institute/Honors Fellowship may not apply for the Hintemeyer Program/ Scholarship and students who apply for the Hintemeyer Program/Scholarship may not apply for the Honors Institute/Honors Fellowship.
