\_\_\_\_\_ Child Support: Provide court document stating termination of benefits.

\_\_\_\_\_ Worker's Compensation: Provide a letter from Bureau of Worker's Compensation stating the termination date of benefits.

\_\_\_\_\_ If child support and/or alimony, a copy of divorce decree to include settlement agreement.

7. One-time income (examples: IRA distribution, back year Social Security payments, etc.)

**Documents Required:**

- Copy of 2017 Federal Tax Transcript -The tax transcript must be requested from the IRS website:  
<https://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript>.
- Documentation of one-time income including amount, type of income, and date of receipt.
- Statement of how funds were spent, invested, or rolled over.
